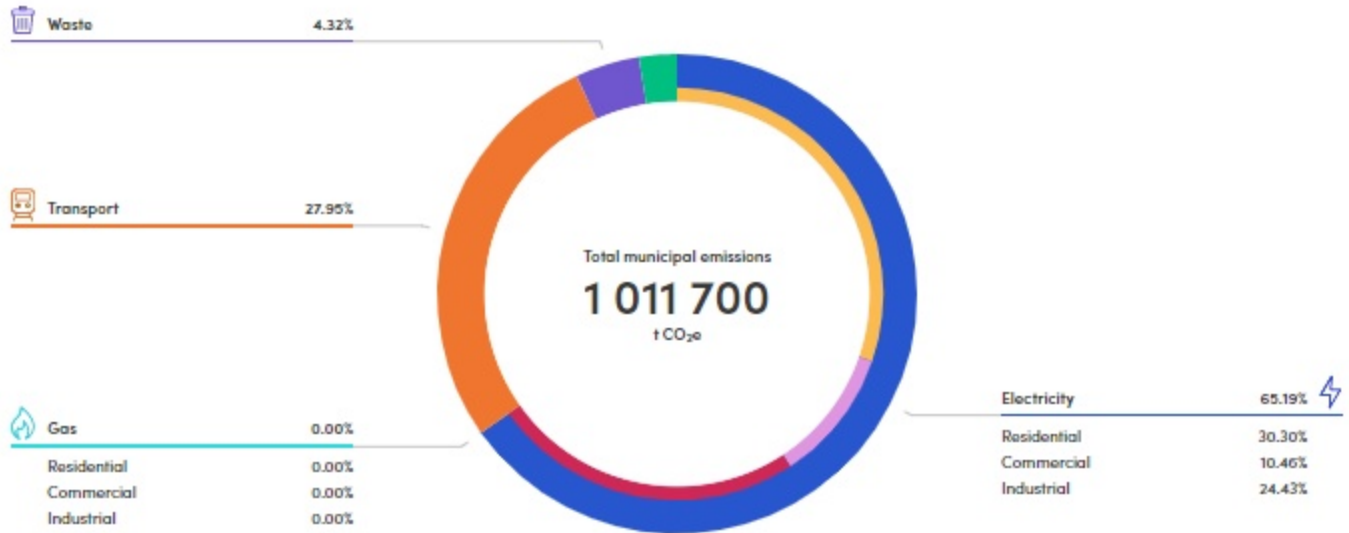


Tweed

2017 municipal emissions snapshot



Tweed is a regional area that is small in area relative to the state average and has a moderate urban density. It's major emissions source is electricity consumption with the majority of this coming from residential electricity consumption.

The carbon emissions for Tweed have had no substantial change since 2005, with a very large proportion of this change occurring in the last few years.
